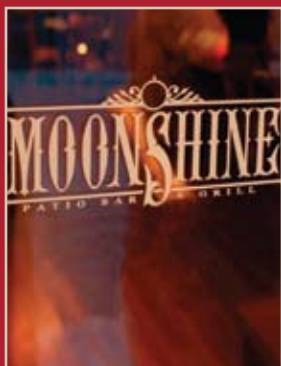
TYLA Teacher Workshop and Capitol Tour
